The Mihaly Russin Scholarship Program:

Each year scholarship awards will be made available by the RBO on a competitive basis. The amount awarded to each student will be \$1,000 per year not to exceed 3 years. Winners of the Mihaly Russin Scholarship may include any students who have completed 4 years of full time college courses. They may have received a college degree, be working towards a Masters Degree, Second B.S. degree, or continuing in a longer program (ie. Medical Doctor, Pharmacist, etc.).

Eligibility:

Students must have a life insurance policy of \$10,000 or more with the RBO. If the membership of the applicant is terminated, then in that event the RBO reserves the right to cancel the scholarship award.

Applying for the Mihaly Russin Scholarship:

1. Members must be/remain active within the society and 2 letters of recommendation should be received. (One by the parish priest as well as one from an individual from the community).
2. Students applying must be a Christian, active in his/her home parish, an individual who is of service to others, and should exhibit the highest standards in character and faith, as well as believes in him/herself, and have a noticeable level of determination to succeed.
3. Complete the attached Mihaly Russin Scholarship Application
4. Complete the attached Mihaly Russin Scholarship Biographical Questionnaire
5. Forward a picture as well as a copy of your transcripts and acceptance letter
